Curb-to-Curb Services



OC ACCESS

Orange County Transit Authority (OCTA)

Reservations: 877-628-2232 | TDD: 800-564-4232

Curb-to-curb service for Orange County residents who are disabled and unable to use regular bus service.

Cost: \$3.60 per one-way trip.

Guidelines: Passengers must meet Americans with Disabilities (ADA) eligibility criteria. Interview and certification by ACCESS required. Modification of service beyond curb must be approved.

Transportation for non-emergency medical appointments.

Cost: \$2 per one-way trip; accompanying care attendants ride free.

Guidelines: South Orange County residents ages 60 and older. Pre-enrollment required. Can provide eight round trips per month. Trips require 48 hours advance notice.

Cost: \$20 annual membership fee; \$5 suggested donation per one-way ride.

Guidelines: Irvine residents ages 60 and older or adults ages 18 with a disability (TRIPS eligible only). Pre-registration required.

City of Irvine shuttle service along fixed routes for community members traveling within City limits.

Cost: Free

Guidelines: Shuttle frequency is every 20 minutes on weekdays from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and weekends from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Daily trips to and from Los Angeles, Santa Barbara and San Diego with stops in Orange County, including Irvine Station.

Cost: Varies based upon route

Guidelines: Visit amtrak.com for information on discounts for seniors ages 65 and older, veterans, persons with disabilities, and their companions.

OC Bus

Bus system with county-wide service.

Cost: \$2 single fare; \$0.75 Seniors (ages 60 and older), persons with disabilities, and Medicare recipients.

Guidelines: Day, weekly, and monthly passes available.

Metrolink

Commuter rail system with service to Los Angeles, Orange, and Riverside Counties.

Cost: Varies based upon route. Senior and disabled discounts available. Attendants ride free with disabled passenger. Proof of disability required.

Guidelines: Tickets purchased at station kiosk. Free online ticketing app also available; search on mobile device in app store for Metrolink (Southern California Regional Rail Authority).
