

Your Business Is Required to Recycle Food Scraps

California's SB 1383 requires all businesses to recycle organic material separately. Keeping organics out of the landfill reduces methane, a pollutant 84 times more potent than CO₂.

- Food scraps (meat, bones, dairy, fruit and vegetable scraps): green bin.
- Food-soiled paper (napkins, paper towels, uncoated cardboard): green bin.
- Yard trimmings, grass, leaves, and small branches: green bin.
- Compostable bags are accepted.
